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EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE:

All animals must be accustomed to being tied and haltered.

Bulls over 6 months must be rung or humbugs used. Bulls must be handled by two people at all times.

Stewards have the right to withdraw any animal that appears to constitute a risk to the public.

This year's show is exempt from pre-movement TB testing.

Entry Fee £6.00 per class. Entries close May 31st 2026.

The North Yorkshire County Show Cattle Committee Perpetual Challenge Trophy will be presented to the exhibitor with the most points in the cattle classes. Points: 1st = 3points, 2nd = 2 pts, 3rd = 1pt

The North Yorkshire County Show Trophy will be presented for the Supreme Dairy Champion. Champions from the Dairy Section to compete.

The Midland Bank Perpetual Challenge Trophy will be presented to the Supreme Beef Champion. Champions from the Beef section will compete.
